OVERVIEW

Indiana Wesleyan University is seeking to establish a strategic partnership with specific Christian schools to create the Wildcat Consortium (WC). The non-exclusive agreement will bring benefit to both parties and seek to promote Christian education in the lives of students, parents, staff and faculty of each participating institution.

BENEFITS TO CHRISTIAN EDUCATIONAL CONSORTIUM

1. Students graduating from Christian Educational Consortium will receive a WC scholarship at IWU. The scholarship will be calculated based on the number of years the student has attended grades 9-12 at Christian Educational Consortium. Christian Educational Consortium must be a member of the WC program at the time of the student's graduation to be eligible for the scholarship.
 - The total amount of the scholarship will be divided equally between the four years of attendance at IWU.
 - The total amount of all scholarships will not exceed the cost of tuition at IWU.

RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

X \$2500 = TOTAL SCHOLARSHIP

NON-RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

(Years at Christian Educational Consortium)

X \$1000 = TOTAL SCHOLARSHIP

2. Students may have access to dual credit courses through IWU's High School Life Calling Institute, offered either online or in a traditional classroom.
3. Parents of students, faculty and staff at Christian Educational Consortium may take undergrad or graduate courses through IWU's CAPS division at a 10% discount (this discount may not be used in addition to other available discounts).
